APPLICATION BY ASDA TO EXTEND OPENING HOURS

Following the planning application submitted by ASDA in November, I met with the organiser of the petition against the application and was also contacted by several residents living nearby.

Last week, I spoke with the Planning Department and, yesterday, received confirmation that the application has been REFUSED, following the concerns from residents.

This means ASDA can only operate within the existing conditions.

They can, however, submit an appeal against this decision to the independent Planning Inspectorate and, if they do, I will contact you again to let you know how you can make your views and concerns known to the inspector who will consider any appeal.
