Arlington Road: requested repair to road surface at junction with Grove Road
Asbury Road: requested pruning of the trees. Confirmed this will be done by March

Bayswater Gardens: grass verges 'spade edged'
Bayswater Road: requested spade edging to grass verges
Bayswater Road: requested replacement 'Give Way' sign at junction with A554
Beaumaris Road: junction markings with Green Lane to be repainted
Beechwood Avenue: requested action on poor road surface
Belvidere Road: reported poor pavement after utility works near Prospect Vale
Belvidere Road: requested grass verges spade edged
Belvidere Road: overflowing bin near shops at Broadway Avenue reported
Broadway Avenue: requested new 'Give Way' sign at junction with Claremount Road
Broadway Avenue: reported leaning streetlight outside no. 44 (now fixed)
Broadway Avenue: requested spade edging to grass verges

Claremount Road: requested repainting of lines near Harrow Road junction
Cross Lane: requested action on faulty street lights

Elleray Park Road: raised concerns of traffic speed with Council Road Safety Manager
Elm Park Road: requested new road sign at junction with Mount Road (again)
Elm Park Road: requested pavement works outside no. 14
Ennerdale Road: notified residents of proposals to improve safety at Mount Road junction

Farndon Avenue: requested 'basal growth' of tree in pavement is pruned
Fieldway: damage to grass verge outside Oldershaw reported
Folly Lane: requested spade edging to grass verge near Buxton Lane junction

G

Green Lane: requested pot holes either side of Wood Lane car park are fixed
Green Lane: requested repainting of 'SLOW' markings on approach to bridge
Greenleas Road: requested weed growth around junction with Leasowe Road is removed
Grove Road: reported faulty bollards on pedestrian island near the Nelson pub
Grove Road: requested weeds at junction with Harrison Drive are removed

Hose Side Road: trees near Seaview Road junction pruned
Hose Side Road: loose bin near Captain's Pit reported and fixed

L

Leasowe Road: weeds and litter near Wallasey Village Station reported and now removed
Leyburn Road: pavement repair requested outside No. 3
Linksvie: met with Network Rail and a resident over new fencing at bridge
Lyndhurst Road: loose paving outside No. 16 reported for repair
Lynton Road: loose paving outside No. 15 reported for repair

Meadway: requested junction markings are repainted

Mockbeggar Drive: loose paving flags outside No. 16 reported for repair

Mockbeggar Wharf: requested spade edging to grass verge. Now completed.

Mount Pleasant Road: damaged streetlights in pedestrian area reported for repair

Mount Road: loose paving outside No. 32 reported for repair. Now completed.

Mount Road: requested basal growth around trees is pruned

Mount Road: requested spade edging to grass verges. Now completed

Newland Drive: requested replacement 'Give Way' sign at junction of Belvidere Road

Newport Avenue: requested spade edging to grass verges at junction with Bayswater Road

Northcote Road: contractor recalled to complete resurfacing works around utility covers

Oldfield Road: reported loose paving at junction with Rolleston Drive. Now completed

Ponsonby Road: loose paving flags near No. 10 reported for repair

Queensway: requested (again) replacement street signs at junctions

Redcar Road: junction markings with Green Lane to be repainted

Roslcare Drive: damage to grass verges caused by vehicles reported for repair

Saltburn Road: requested planting of small 'island' green. Now completed

Sea Road: requested removal of build up of leaf waste. Now completed.

Sea Road: notified residents of latest consultation for junction improvements at Grove Road

Seaview Road: reported litter build up on private land near Massey Park for attention

St George's Road: loose paving flags near No. 46 and No. 136 reported for repair

St Hilary Brow: requested gully clearance near to rockface

St Hilary Drive: requested replacement litter bin on amenity space

Studley Road: leaning tree in pavement reported for inspection

The Coppice: requested connection of new street light at Glen Park Road junction

Valkyrie Road: to be resurfaced by April

Vyner Road: loose paving at junction with Belvidere Road reported for action

W

Wallacre Road: pedestrian barrier at junction with Mosslands Drive to be replaced

Warren Drive: loose/sunken paving outside numbers 27a, 47 and 51 reported for action

Winchester Drive: entry between here and Newland Drive to be cleared (at last!)

Wood Lane: requested inspection of car park to see if it can be resurfaced
