At the local council elections on 4th May, Lesley and Ian were re-elected as your local councillors. Sadly, Steve missed out by just 57 votes. However, all three of us will continue to work together on local issues here in Wallasey between now and the next council elections in 2027.

We are very grateful to all those who voted for us, including those people who told us they vote differently at General Elections.

LABOUR MISSES OUT ON CONTROL OF THE COUNCIL

As a result, Labour failed to gain outright control of Wirral Council – something which many people told us they did not want to see happen again. Wirral remains a Labour-led Council but they must work with others to pass any proposals in the Town Hall.




